

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM IN BIOETHICS (CPB)

Application Process

Two applications need to be made. The **first** one goes to one (or more) of the following nine home graduate units with which we collaborate: Rehabilitation Sciences Institute (RSI); Institute of Health Policy, Management and Evaluation (IHPME); Institute of Medical Science (IMS); Faculty of Law (LAW); Faculty of Nursing (NUR); Department of Philosophy (PHL); Department of Public Health Sciences (PHS); Department and Centre for the Study of Religion (RLG); Leslie Dan Faculty of Pharmacy (PHAR); and Faculty of Social Work (SW). Note that “Bioethics” must be entered in Box 22 Collaborative Program on the School of Graduate Studies (SGS) application form so that your interest in the CPB is noted by SGS. You cannot be admitted into the CPB prior to admittance into a home unit, and admission into a home unit does not guarantee admission into the CPB.

The **second** application goes to the Collaborative Program in Bioethics (ideally at the same time as the application to the home unit) and consists of filling out the section below and sending a full application to the CPB. The CPB requires an up-to-date *CV*, *transcripts*, *two letters of reference*, and a *one-page letter of intent* which will explain why you’re interested in the CPB, outline the research project you’re planning to do and provide the reasons why you chose this particular research project, describe the research methodology that will be used to complete the project, explain what you think you’ll get from the CPB and what you’ll give to the CPB, and what you intend to do once the CPB is completed.

The **deadline** for receipt of applications to the CPB is March 31st; applications should be sent to Rhonda Martin, Executive Assistant, Collaborative Program in Bioethics, Joint Centre for Bioethics, 155 College St., Suite 754, University of Toronto. If your application to a home unit is successful, please notify the Executive Assistant at jcb.ea@utoronto.ca as soon as possible so that your application can be considered by the CPB.

All CPB applications are assessed by the CPB Executive Committee (consisting of a representative from each collaborating unit); the Executive Assistant will notify you of the Committee’s decision concerning your application.
